HARRY SHALAN has waited for three months to hear from his wife DEANNA, who went away to decide if she could deal with the dangerous nature of his job as a private detective. Before Harry can get out of town, Deanna reappears. After a long discussion and a few other extracurricular activities, Harry offers to give up his job, but Deanna concedes that for him to do that would be to give up being the man she fell in love with. She would rather live with the fear of losing him than live with herself knowing she had allowed him to stop being the hero he was born to be. Harry drives to Chicago to search for Johnny Tuttle. Deanna plans to fly out the next day and join Harry. She doesn't make it, though, as she is kidnapped. BERNHARD STULTZ, one of her captors, is a dark version of Harry himself, although the version of the chivalric code by which he governs his life varies somewhat from Harry's. Regardless, Stultz agrees to free Deanna in exchange for a promise from Harry that he will drop the search for Tuttle. Finally back in each other's arms, Deanna and Harry decide the best way to cope with the danger of Harry's profession is to share it, so they become private eye partners. Fast forward five months. Harry and Deanna are enjoying Thanksgiving dinner at his parents' house when Harry finds he has several missed calls and some ominous voicemails from Tuttle. A cop friend informs Harry and Deanna that the calls have originated from a cell near the Shalans' house, so Deanna and Harry, hoping to save Johnny, hike home through a freak snowstorm. They find him hiding there, exhausted and injured. He weaves a chilling tale of

how, several years earlier, with a seemingly innocent ten dollar bet, Johnny lit a fire of gambling addiction that took months to quench. By the time he got control of himself again, he'd gambled away his entire life savings and allowed himself to become hopelessly in debt to his mob-connected bookie. The next morning, Harry awakes to find that Bernhard Stultz has reappeared. Knowing that Stultz lives by his own code, Harry encourages Johnny to tell his story in the hopes that the hit man will see the injustice of taking Johnny and his wife back to face certain death at the hands of Stultz' boss, Merton Bell. Harry's instincts are right, and Stultz agrees to appeal to Bell on Johnny's behalf. In the meantime, Harry, Deanna, and Johnny, along with Johnny's wife Lilith, go on the run. But no matter how hard they work to cover their tracks, it seems that Bell's men are waiting for them. Eventually, Harry and Deanna begin to suspect that Lilith is hiding something. Their fears are confirmed when Lilith suddenly disappears, leaving behind evidence that she has not only been in touch with Bell, but has been carrying on an affair with him. Johnny, unhinged by this revelation, bolts from Harry and Deanna back to Chicago to get back the woman he loves. Harry and Deanna rush to Bell's home to find Johnny Tuttle and Merton Bell in a standoff with Bell holding Lilith hostage. Harry and Deanna step in, but an unexpected turn of events leaves Harry clinging to life and Deanna praying for a miracle.

Mixing with Your Mind

In June 1980, 19-year-old James McDonnell (known as Slim Jim Phantom) boarded a plane from New York City to London with his childhood friends and bandmates Brian Setzer and Lee Rocker. In less than a year, they went from being homeless, hungry, and living in punk rock squats to the toast of the London music scene. The

Stray Cats developed a signature sound and style that swept across the world, released multiplatinum albums, and were embraced and befriended by classic rock acts like the Rolling Stones and Led Zeppelin, as well as original punk heroes such as the Sex Pistols, the Damned, and the Clash, and rock-and-roll originators Carl Perkins and Jerry Lee Lewis. After ten years of marriage to actress Britt Ekland, Slim Jim moved down the hill to Sunset Strip, where his son was raised and he owned the world-famous rock-and-roll bar Cat Club while continuing to play with a host of well-known musicians. Slim Jim, a veteran of the London and LA music scenes, recounts in his memoir not just the Stray Cats' rise but a different type of life spent in the upper echelon of rock-and-roll stardom.

The Complete DX7II

Willis examines the many orientations and perspectives of reporters that gather and present the news of the day. Debunking the notion that there are limited perspectives journalists may use, Willis examines up to 15 different orientations that reporters bring to their work. These perspectives run the gamut, from the traditional approach of distancing oneself completely from events and people involved to becoming part of the story's fabric to ascertain the story's true essence. Willis also suggests that, for many stories, it is wholly appropriate for journalists to feel what a non-professional would experience at such an event, and to allow those emotions to fuel the reporting and writing of the story. Several

examples are discussed in detail, including the coverage of the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995, and the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001.

The post-9/11 world has witnessed a rebirth of irregular and asymmetrical warfare, which, in turn, has led to an increase in conflicts between conventional armies and non-state armed groups. In their haste to respond to the threat from insurgencies, nations often fail to plan effectively not only for combat operations but also for withdrawal, which is inevitable, win or lose. In order to answer the question of how to withdraw from engagement with an insurgency, Gleis examines how insurgencies are conducted and what, if anything, is unique about an Islamist insurgency. He then proposes ways to combat these groups successfully and to disentangle one's military forces from the war once strategic objectives have been met—or once it is clear that they cannot be. Because this type of warfare is dynamic and ever-changing, this book is not meant to suggest a set of cookie-cutter solutions for how to withdraw from insurgencies. Rather, the author analyzes

six counterinsurgency operations that have taken place in the past, with the intention of gleaning from them as many lessons as possible to better prepare for future withdrawals. The literature on how wars end has failed to explore irregular warfare. This much needed reexamination serves as an indispensable starting point.
