WebLogic Server takes the certificate information from that header, trusting that it came from a secure source (the plug-in) and uses that information to authenticate the user. For this reason, if you set `clientCertProxy`, use a connection filter to ensure that WebLogic Server accepts connections only from the machine on which the plug-in is
